## What replace strings can I use in the subject and message?

The following are replace strings you can use in the subject line and the message (email body).

{OrgName} - The name of the organization.

{OrgUnitCode} - The code for the org unit.

{OrgUnitName} - The name of the org unit.

{OrgUnitStartDate} - The start date specified for the org unit.

{OrgUnitEndDate} - The end date specified for the org unit.

{InitiatingUserFirstName} - The first name of the initiating user.

{InitiatingUserLastName} - The last name of the initiating user.

{InitiatingUserUserName} - The username of the initiating user.

{InitiatingUserOrgDefinedId} - The Org Defined ID of the initiating user.

{LoginPath} - The address of the login path for the site.








# INTELLIGENT AGENT – AGENT LIST

You can create several agents with different criteria. You can schedule your agents to run or you can manually run your agents.

## INTELLIGENT AGENT MESSAGES TO INSTRUCTORS

After an agent runs, the instructor receives an email message that confirms the agent ran, and indicates whether action was taken. The “action” the agent takes is sending email messages to students who met the criteria. If no students met the criteria, Action Taken would be “No”. Example of a Message:

The following agent has finished running:

Org Unit: May2010V9TestCourse - May 2010 Version 9 Test Course

Agent: No Login

Request Submitted: Thursday, May 27, 2010, 8:04:18 AM

Agent Completed: Thursday, May 27, 2010, 8:04:20 AM

Action Taken: Yes





# INTELLIGENT AGENTS—E-MAIL MESSAGES TO STUDENTS

- The instructor does not know which students received the message, only that the agent was run and action was taken
- If instructor wants to know which students receive the message, instructor can put his/her own email address in the cc: or bc: field of the email message
- The instructor will receive a copy of each message that the agent generates for each student
- That can be a lot of messages, but it is the only way to get that information
- A feature request has been submitted to D2L to provide the instructor with the list of students who received the message in a single e-mail to the instructor
